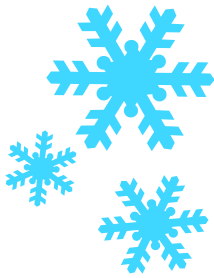
Extended Daycare (EDC)

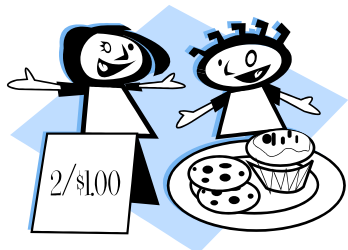

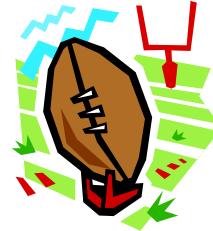
